

VEOLIA UPDATE

(Bay Park Water Reclamation Facility)

Parks Update: Veolia & Long Beach Consolidation

Thank you to everyone who attended our quarterly Veolia meeting, both in person and virtually!

Please see below for updates: LB Consolidation:

*Residents with concerns about home foundations due to construction vibrations can email info@longbeachconsolidation.org

*While major work on First Avenue is complete, the remaining construction in park is expected to be complete by April, park fully restored by July.

*Flooding in the parking lot across from the Police Marine Station should improve with new grating. Veolia:

*Their odor study is completed, with results to be shared at our next meeting.

*Upcoming primary tank vacing (degreasing) is pending county approval, and we will be alerted as soon as the start date is confirmed as this will temporarily increase odors for several weeks. Veolia is trying to get this to begin asap as the park is less busy this time of year.
